


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# GENERAL AWARENESS ABOUT AYUSH SYSTEM OF MEDICINE & POPULARITY OF AYURVED IN RATNAGIRI DISTRICT

The world is looking at Ayurved as a solution for many disorders. Ayurved is a life science originated in India which emphasizes on prevention of diseases than its cure. Use of Ayurvedic system of medicine started declining and reached its nadir during the British rule. Ministry of AYUSH is giving boost to regeneration of Ayurved and other allied systems of medicine. Public health initiative scheme is one of its efforts to deliver Ayurved in society. MES Ayurved Mahavidyalaya in collaboration with Ministry of AYUSH conducted Ayurved awareness assessment with questionnaire. This study is an attempt to analyze popularity of AYUSH and Ayurved in north Ratnagiri district of Maharashtra. As a result of this survey it was clear that efforts for propagation and percolation of Ayurved are yet to show desired results and people are ready to accept AYUSH system of medicine.

### INTRODUCTION

Ayurved – the ancient science of life was practiced and used in India since time immemorial. The time tasted principles of Ayurved¹ were documented after through research. Over centuries of foreign rule in the Indian subcontinent, the use of Ayurved started declining² and reached its nadir during the British rule. Since independence the situation didn't improve as expected with the allopathic system of medicine taking over as the conventional medical system and Ayurved pushed to the fringes of health care set up.

It is only in the last few years that this system has been actively promoted and popularized. Setting up of the independent Ministry of AYUSH was an extremely important step in this direction. Since its

inception, the ministry has taken numerous steps to promote the popularity of authentic *Ayurved*<sup>3</sup>. Emphasis is placed on research and development of modern modalities for application of principles of *Ayurved*. Various schemes and programs have been set up for tackling of different health related issues. The focus is slowly shifting from a disease oriented approach to health promotional aspect.

MES Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, *Ghanekhuntlote*, *Khed*, District- *Ratnagiri*, *Maharashtra* State was allotted with Public Health Initiative Scheme funded by Ministry of AYUSH under AYUSH PHI Scheme<sup>4</sup>, sanctioned on 15/07/2016. One of the key deliverables of this scheme was to assess awareness about AYUSH system of

medicine & popularity of Ayurved in Ratnagiri district. Following study is a result of survey conducted in North part of Ratnagiri district.

## **MATERIALS & METHOD**

A questionnaire of 09 questions was drafted to assess status of AYUSH system of medicine and popularity of Ayurved. This questionnaire was translated in regional

language so as to present no problem in understanding spirit of question. objectives were duly explained to each and every respondent. Doubts if any were clarified at the same time. Data was collected from responses of questions and then this data was analyzed, presented in charts and tables.




Table No.4-.Bar diagram showing awareness of people about Ayurved




Table No -5.Bar diagram awareness about availability of *Ayurvedic* practitioner




Table No -6.Bar diagram showing people opted *Ayurved* for treatment




Table No -7. Bar diagram showing people who are regularly practicing *Yoga* 



Table No -8. Bar diagram showing awareness of people about *Panchkarma* 




Table No **-9.** Bar diagram showing number of people/family member who received *Panchkarma* treatment



Table No -10.Bar diagram showing awareness of people regarding availability of *Ayurvedic* medicine in government hospitals





Table No -11.Bar diagram showing people who are ready to accept *Ayurved* for their treatment in future




# **RESULT**

According to survey it was seen that most of the people are unaware about AYUSH system of medicine (99%) and Ayurvedic treatment (69%). About 75% of people are aware about some Ayurved practitioner in their area but only 9% are actually receiving Ayurvedic treatment for some or other aliment. Though people had heard much about Yoga but only 2% are actually practicing Yoga regularly. 95% of people are still not aware of Panchkarma that is why only 3% of people actually received Panchkarma for their treatment. 23% people are aware that Ayurvedic medicines are available in Government hospitals like primary health center (PHC), rural hospitals (RH), etc. Among 4099 respondents 84% people are ready to accept Ayurvedic treatment.

#### DISCUSSION

Ayurved is ancient science which originated in India & getting importance worldwide again. Ministry of AYUSH is working hard along with all stakeholders to regain glory of Ayurved. Public Health Initiative [PHI] scheme is one of their efforts for propagating Ayurved till grass root level.

Motive of this scheme is to assess awareness. deliver quality Ayurvedic treatment & service to society. As a result of this study conducted under PHI scheme, it was found that many people are still not aware of AYUSH & Ayurvedic modalities of treatment. Though people had heard much about Ayurved, they haven't actually started using it for their healthcare & wellness. Thus Modern medical science is still a primary treatment accepted by mass in northern Ratnagiri district. area of acceptance towards Awareness and Ayurveda is gradually increasing but sill much work is yet to be done for making Ayurved mainstream treatment. Exhibitions, healthcare camps & different programs like International Yoga Day added pace in awareness building. Ayushmaan Bhaarat Yojana will be a boost for delivering standardized Ayurvedic treatment protocol helping people accept AYUSH. Considering current situation, Health checkup camps, rally, poster presentations, road exhibition, seminars, awareness play, lectures, different schemes are still very much required for improving awareness and AYUSH acceptance among rural people in *Ratnagiri* district.

# **CONCLUSION**

The above results shows that all the efforts taken by the Ministry of AYUSH for propagation and percolation of *Ayurved* and AYUSH system of medicine to grass root levels, are yet to show the desired results. All the stakeholders need to further contribute towards achieving this goal.
